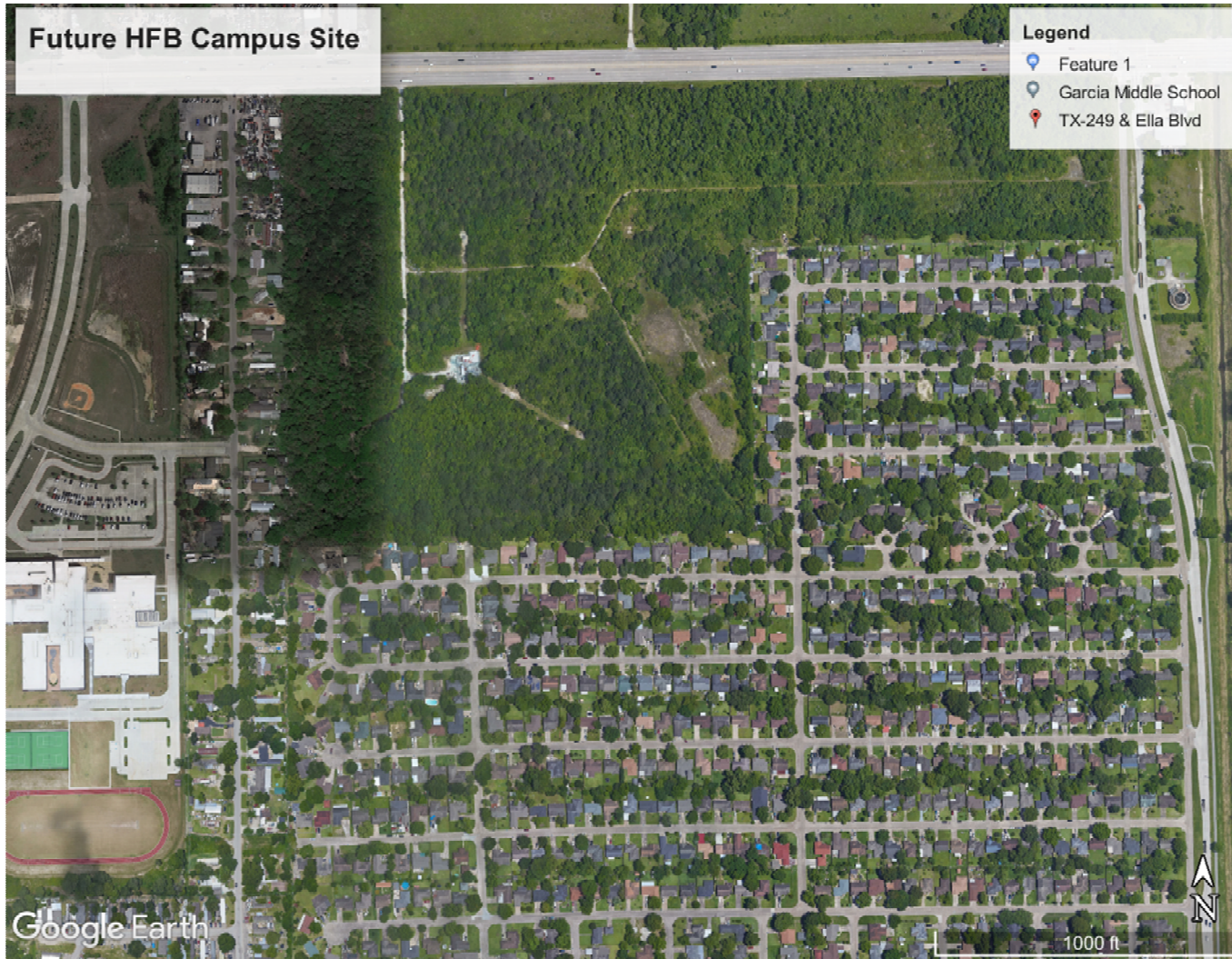
Construction Activities: February 2023

- Construction fencing installation begins around site perimeter
- Contractor clearing equipment moves on site
- Clearing begins on the east end of the site, adjacent to Ella Blvd, and progresses west
- All construction parking contained to the site

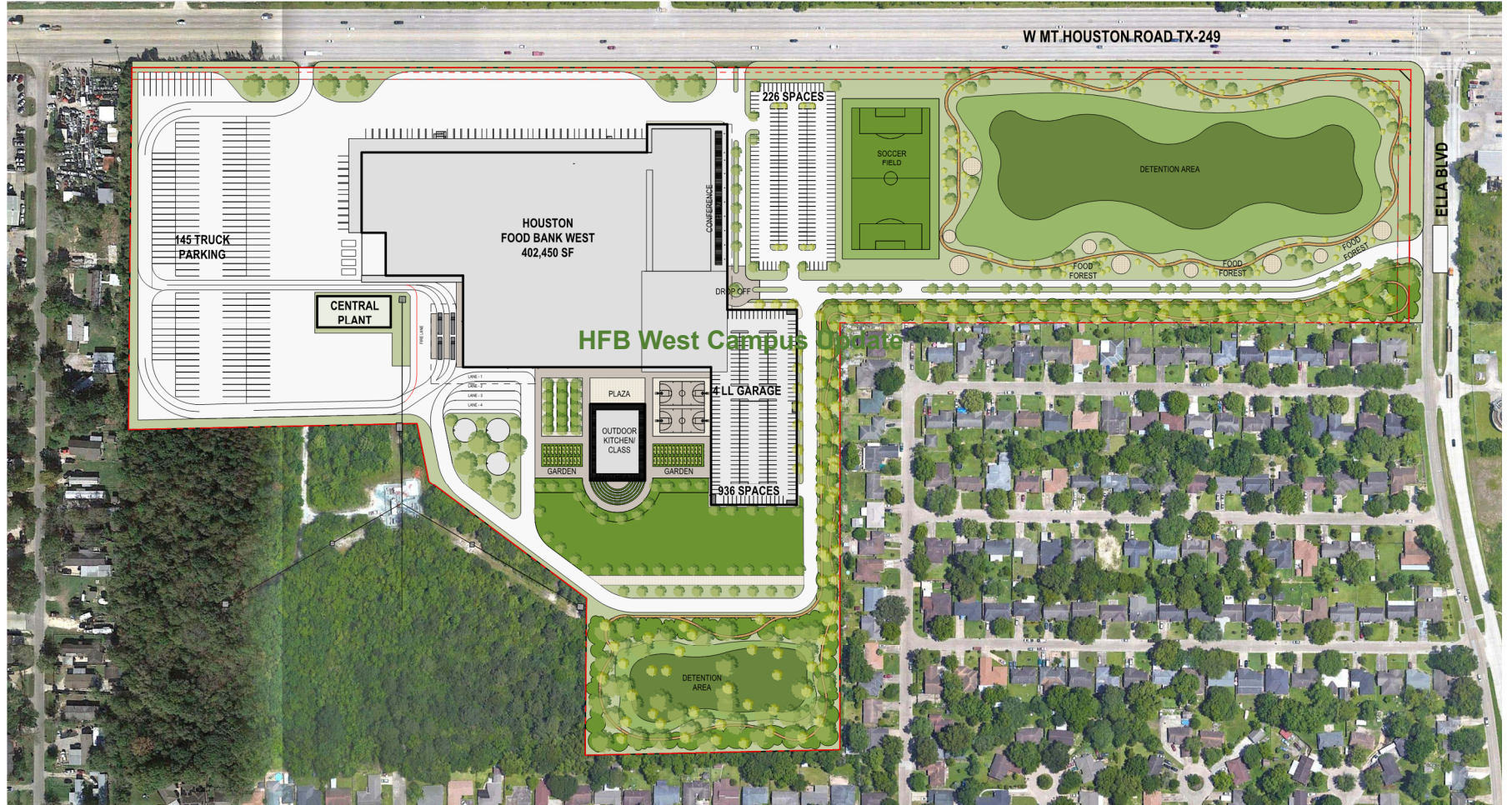
What to Expect During this Phase

- Cleared material haul-off along W. Mount Houston Rd
- All cleared materials to be hauled off; no onsite burning will be conducted
- 50-ft deep buffer zone of existing trees will be retained along the entire southeast portion of the property, adjacent to Heather Glenn subdivision
- Clearing and excavating activities to take place during normal working hours, Mon-Fri weekly

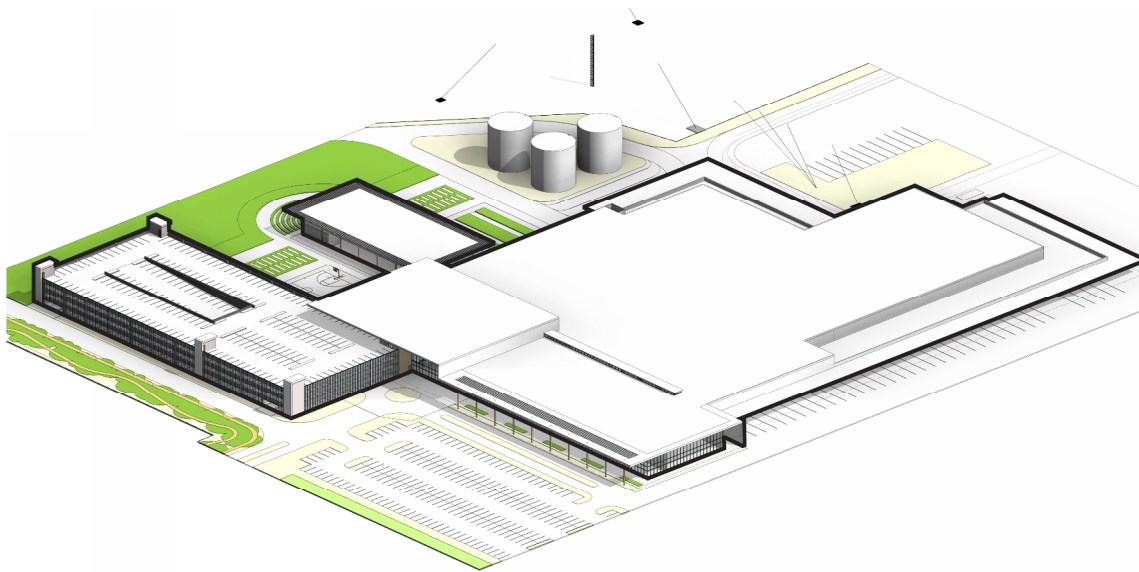
Current Site Plan
